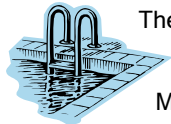


### Clean Up Day May 20<sup>th</sup>

### Message from the President

The 173 families comprising our Association provide the sole support for the maintenance, management, and upkeep of our recreation areas. For a variety of reasons, we have reason to

be concerned that non-paying, non-residents may be utilizing our facilities, contributing to the wear and tear, but not financially to the repair. We also believe that with the completion of the new housing in front of the driving range, additional non-residents may seek out our pool area and adopt it as their own.

Currently, we have no screening system, ID system, or monitoring system to insure that only residents and their guests use our facilities. This year we are going to set up a system where volunteers may ask you or your children to provide validation that you in fact do belong to our Association. On average, we have about a dozen new families move into the neighborhood every year and at the start of the season, no one may recognize them or be able to tell them apart from a non-resident.

Please advise family members who are old enough to visit the pool without supervision, that they may be asked some questions by a member of the Board of Directors, while inside the gates of the pool. Those using the pool will be asked their exact address and last name.

We hope no one is offended when asked to validate their residency and we hope that this small step keeps our pool area, our pool area.
