At the May meeting, a Board Member raised the question of the Association's legal liability with respect to providing alcohol at Association functions. This does not refer to BYOB - only to Association purchased alcohol. Since this is a very legitimate concern and a very good question, some preliminary investigation was conducted. And, it is evident that in order to protect both the Association and its individual members further legal advice needs to be obtained. Thus, the Board is in the process of securing additional legal advice with respect to this issue. While we are addressing this issue, things will operate as they have in the past. But, this question does need to be addressed expediently and so we are actively investigating this issue.
