July 22nd Meeting Highlights:

- A new video security surveillance system will be installed covering SHRA grounds (e.g. Clubhouse, pool, tennis courts, etc.). As you know, we continue to battle those that do not respect our property and this latest edition to security will assist us in deterring vandalism or any other unlawful activities on SHRA grounds. In addition to this system, signs will be installed in several locations throughout the property indicating that skateboarding, inline skating, and bicycling is prohibited.
- The Board voted to hire an attorney to further investigate the alcohol policy of our Association. We will report back when we have more information.
- In preparation for resurfacing the tennis courts, the Board will begin working on developing documentation for the financing that will be needed. Before year end, Association members will be receiving information on this topic as an affirmative vote is necessary.
- In accordance with the new "No Smoking" law in Ohio, there will be "No Smoking" signs placed inside the Clubhouse.
- Please continue to sign yourself and your guest into the pool.
- Remember, any event with more than 10 attendees requires the homeowner to be present and the pool or facility to be rented.
- The guidelines below will be used to assign the appropriate number of lifeguards to a pool party. The "Number of People" guideline is based on total party attendees, not estimated swimmers. As always, the sponsoring resident needs to be in attendance at all times.

- 1-24 Attendees (After Hours) 1 Lifeguard
- 11-24 Attendees (During normal Pool Hours) 1 Lifeguard
- 25-59 Attendees 2 Lifeguards
- 60-99 Attendees 3 Lifeguards
- 100+ 4 Lifeguards

It is destructive to the facilities and also dangerous. The Board is in the process of purchasing signage for these locations. However, we need your assistance! Please remind your children that this is an activity that is strictly prohibited. We want to protect their safety and also the enjoyment of all that belong to our Association.
