#### President's Report:

- Minutes from last meeting were reviewed and approved. The web page was discussed. We reviewed sample pages of the website that Frank has been working on. Frank will get with Ed to get final questions answered. We would like to have the website up and running by June.

#### Vandalism:

- The lights are now coming on when motion is detected. Thanks, Mike! The "Reward Fliers" were approved and delivered to members. There has been a great deal of community interest, information, and concern being generated over the vandalism issue. The Warren County Sheriff's Department has conducted several interviews and the investigation is still on going. Frank will look into web cameras and the costs.

#### Old Business:

##### Capital Expenditures – Willie

- Outbuilding is almost complete and looks great! A shelf needs to be installed so we can store the pool cover. Main and Toddler Pool pumps need to be replaced. The age is not known and SHRA has rebuilt the main pool pump a couple of times in the past. *Update:* New pumps have been installed for the main and the toddler pools.

##### Pool – Willie

- Pool pumps, toddler deck, and filters were discussed. No other news.

##### Tennis Courts

- Crack to be fixed shortly. New net assembly coming in soon. *Update:* New net is installed and the cracks are fixed.

##### Grounds – Frank

- Would like a list of names of the vendors that handle the grounds & trash pick up. *Update:* List emailed to Frank by Theresa.

##### Clubhouse – Mike

- Lights have been replaced on the outside. Mike has also received information about getting rid of the smell in the Clubhouse from the raccoons. A motion was made to forgo the cleaning of the Clubhouse and use the money to get rid of the smell. Willie seconded the motion and the motion was passed. *Update:* The Clubhouse was treated twice to rid the smell. To date, there are 6 rentals scheduled for the Clubhouse. We also reviewed the pool rental policy.
